		Payment of the 15% advance payment shall be subject to submission of plans as well as timelines which indicate the milestones for the nine (9)-month project. Additionally, winning bidder must post an irrevocable letter of credit or bank guarantee for an equivalent amount of the advance payment as provided under Section 4 of the Annex "D" of the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184.			
		The security required for the said advance payment is in addition to the Performance Security which will be required upon issuance of Notice of Award pursuant to Section 39 of the revised IRR of RA 9184.
